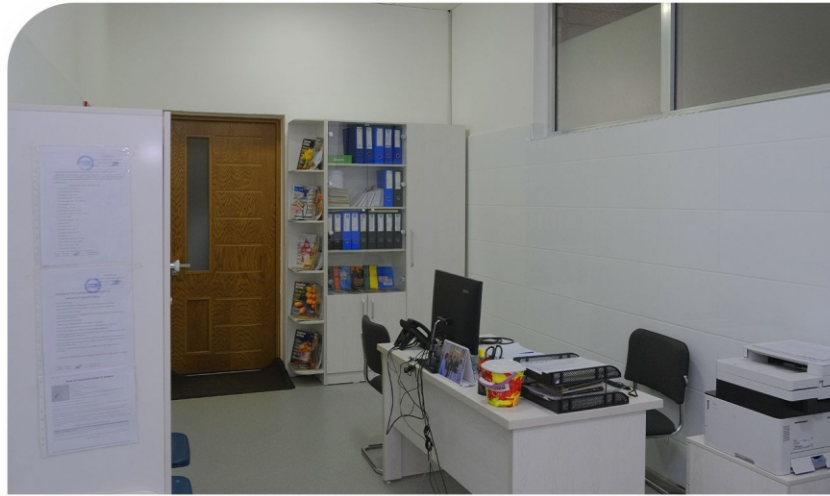

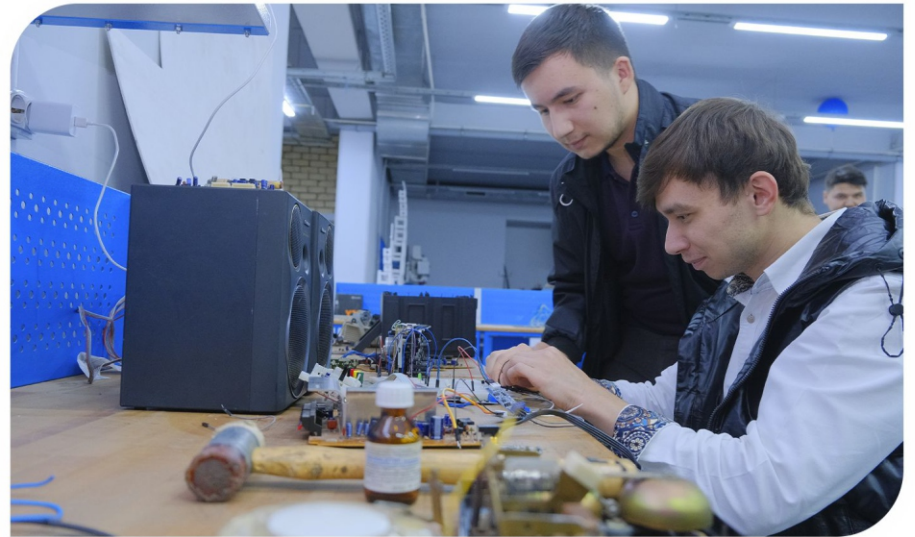

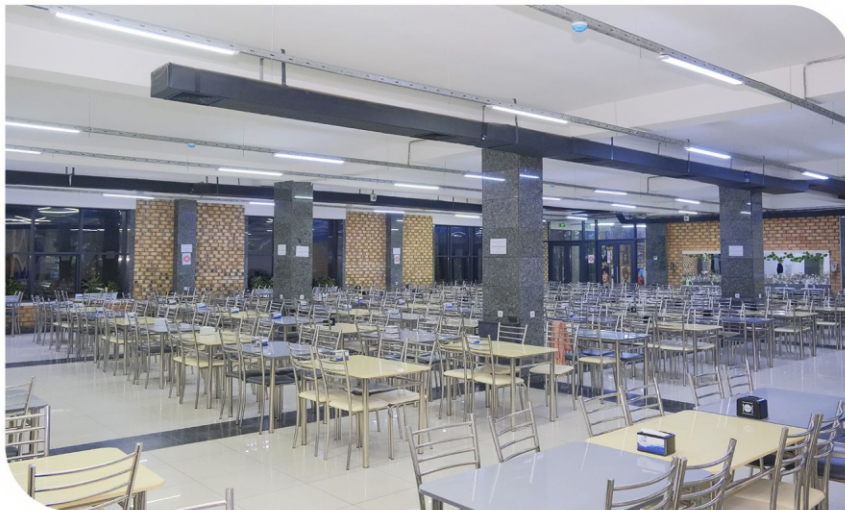

A project focused on training qualified specialists in the installation, maintenance, and management of medical equipment.

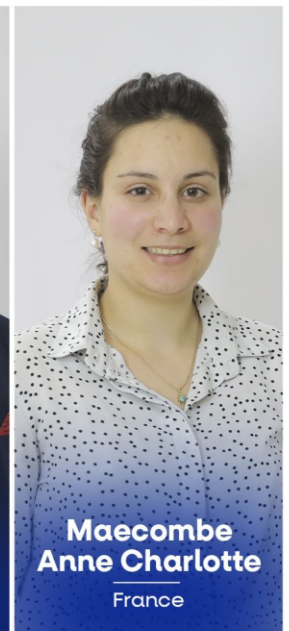

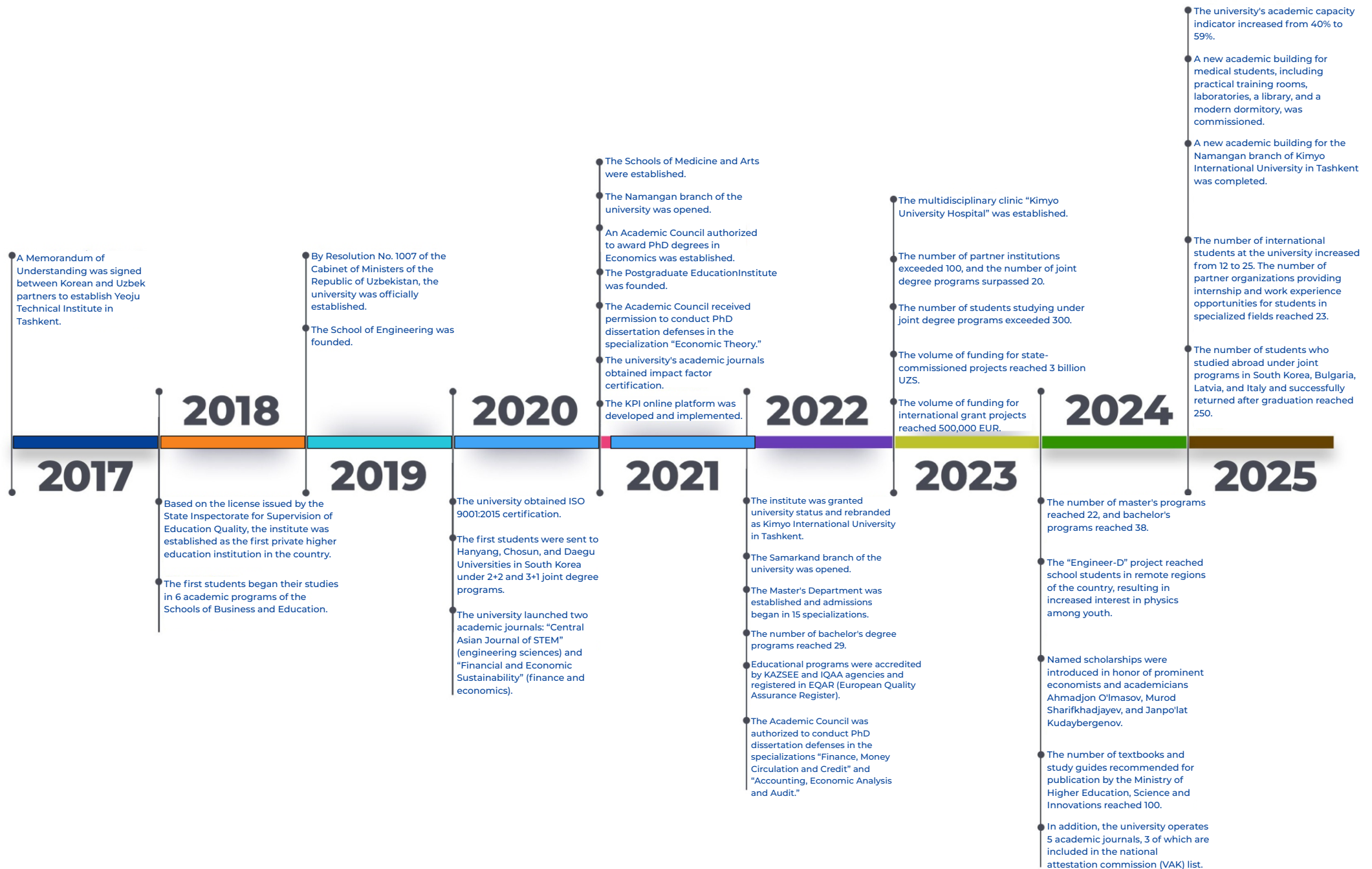
A project aimed at strengthening gender equality in Uzbekistan by developing entrepreneurial skills among women and girls.

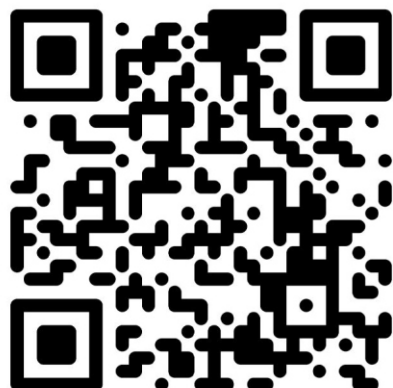
