Program overview

Kimyo International University in Tashkent (KIUT) is pleased to offer a comprehensive 4-week and 2-week Summer and Winter School Program for international students seeking academic learning, cultural immersion, and an affordable global experience.

The program seamlessly combines Uzbek, Russian and English-taught courses, practical workshops, and rich cultural activities.



Academic Tracks

Students will select one main academic track for the duration of the program:

Track 1: Artificial Intelligence & Digital Technologies

Designed for students interested in modern technologies. Focus areas include Artificial Intelligence, Data Analysis, Mobile App Development, and Digital Platforms. Practical components involve identifying a real-world problem and creating a digital solution or prototype. Includes a field trip to Technopark.



Track 2: Business & Entrepreneurship

Focused on developing an entrepreneurial mindset. Key areas include Startup Development, Business Strategy, Innovation, and Marketing. Practical components involve idea generation, market problem identification, and pitching a business model. Includes a field trip to a leading commercial bank in Uzbekistan.





Track 3: Uzbek Language & Cultural Studies

Designed for students interested in Uzbekistan's language, history, and traditions. Focus areas include Basic Uzbek Language, Cultural Heritage, History, and Intercultural Communication. Practical components include language practice, cultural workshops, and visits to historical and cultural sites across Uzbekistan.

KIUT offers a comprehensive, student-friendly package. Support includes accommodation in dormitories, airport pick-up, local transportation, visa support and full access to campus facilities. A group of friendly and dedicated Uzbek student volunteers will accompany the guests throughout the program to assist with translation and cultural immersion.

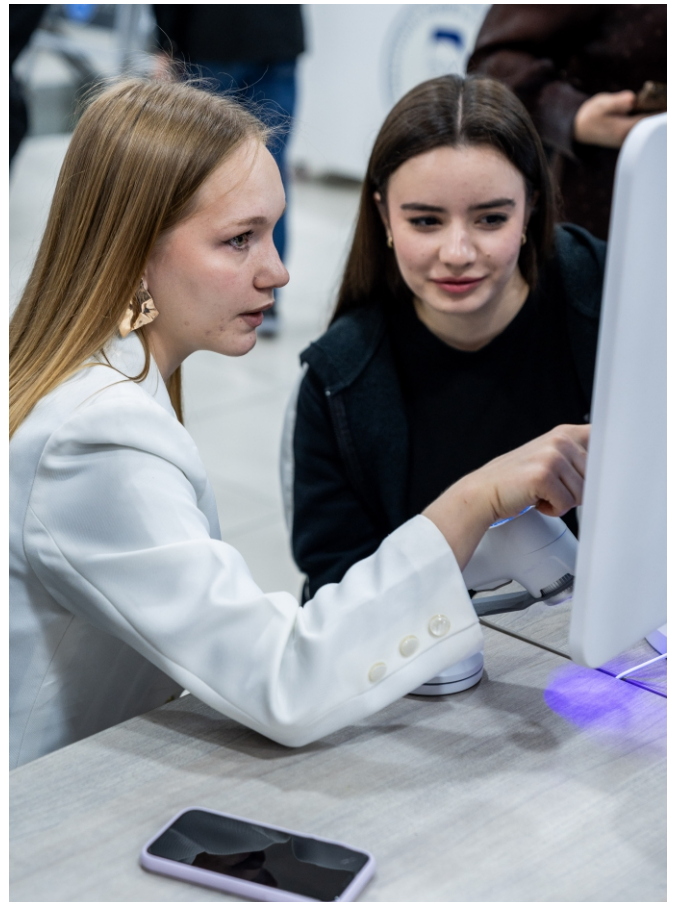
